

paragraph 5 above, or its duly designated representative, shall have the right and power to cut or authorize the cutting and laying out of one or more streets or roads through said Lot 160 or any of the lots designated as Lots 219-249, inclusive, and to use the same or any part thereof for a street or road connecting said new subdivision with the property shown as Section III of Belle Meade, and said committee, or its duly designated representative, shall have the further right and power to recut or authorize the recutting of any lot or lots so as to face the same on any new cut street or road, provided, however, that the provisions of this paragraph 6 shall apply only to such vacant or unimproved lots as may be owned by Derby Heights, Inc. at the time such streets or roads are or may be cut or laid out.
