

AMENDED AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

THAT on the 14th of September, 1956 Webster Oil Company, Inc. a South Carolina corporation whose address is Greenville, South Carolina as Lessors and Phillips Petroleum Company a corporation with offices in Bartlesville, Oklahoma as Lessees, entered into a Lease Amendment, amending Lease Agreement and S. S. Lease, the latter being recorded in the Office of R.M.C. of Greenville County in Deed Book 564, page 331, said Amendment correcting property description recorded in said Lease Agreement and S. S. Lease;

NOW, in consideration of the agreements herein made and exchanged and to correct an erroneous description wherein the Lease Amendment stated the property to be located in Spartanburg County, the parties amend said Lease Amendment by revising line 5 of the beginning paragraph of the Lease Amendment to read as follows:
