All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being known and designated as Tract No. 2 of the Milton Trammell property, as shown on a survey and plat of the same made by W. A. Hester, Surveyor, July 31, 1923, and having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, as shown by said plat, to-wit:
