

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The City of Greenville, South. Carolina, its successors and assigns, forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being composed of two lots in Blue Ridge Forest, property of Carolina Mountains, Inc., and having the following description:

VILLA SITE "A", begins at an iron pin by the side of a bridle trail; running thence (S. 63-12 W., 83.9 feet; thence S. 75-49 W., 115.1 feet; S. 3-7 W., 58.9 feet; S. 78-44 W., 137.9 feet; N. 26-18 W., 154.5 feet; N. 1-44 E., 73.4 feet; N. 11-10 E., 105 feet; N. 43-18 E., 92.3 feet; N. 65 57 F. N. 65-57 E., 152.8 feet; S.35 E., 321 feet; S. 28-30 W., 33.8 feet to an iron pin at the beginning corner.

This lot contains 2.61 acres more or less and is the same property conveyed to Clarence A. Lightner and Frances M. Lightner by deed of Carolina Mountains, Inc., dated January 14, 1927, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 131, page 12.

VILLA SITE "AA", begins at an iron pin in the Western edge of Piedmont Drive; running thence in a Southeastern direction along said Drive, 75 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 57-20 W., 293 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 8-25 W., 52 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 28-30 E., 33.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 35-W., 178 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 84-55 E., 237 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 80-15 E., 67 feet to an iron pin at the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to Clarence A. Lightner and Frances M. Lightner by deed of Carolina Mountains, Inc., dated April 25, 1927, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 131, page 14. This property was sold for taxes and purchased by G. H. Bridgeman from the deliquent tax collector for Greenville County by deed dated January 11, 1946, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 285, page 325. The heirs of the said Clarence A. Lightner and Frances M. Lightner, Alice Lightner Hopf, Clarence M. Lightner, Theodore A. Lightner and Martha Lightner White have released any interest they may have in this property by their several deeds to the City of Greenville to be recorded herewith.
