All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the east side of Mayflower Avenue and being known and designated as Lot No. 11 in the subdivision known as Pecan Terrace, plat of which is recorded in the R.
