

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Leo B. Skinner and Zula B. Skinner, their hoirs and assigns forever,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land lying, being and situate about three miles Northwest of the Town of Greer, on the South side of State Highway no.101 (also known as the Gilreath Mill Road) in Oneal Township, County and State aforesaid, and containing One and 12/100 (1.12) acres, more or less, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit: Beginning on a Nail and Stopper in the center of said road, joint corner of the R. B. Mason Estate property, and running thence with the R. B. Mason Estate property line S.1-05 E.18 feet to an Iron Pin on the South side of said road, thence continuing with the same course for a total distance of 248 feet to an Iron Pin on said property line, thence N.81-05 W.200 feet to an Iron Pin, thence N.1-05 W.248 feet to the center of said road (Iron Pin back on line at 18 feet), thence with the center of said road S.81-05 E.200 feet to the beginning point.
