

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Gantt Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 48 of a subdivision known as South Forest Estates, according to a plat thereof prepared by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, August 29, 1955, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG, at Pages 181, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Brantford Lane, the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 47 and 48, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 84-41 E. 125 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 37 and 38; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 37, N. 5-19 W. 80 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 49; thence along the line of that lot, S. 84-41-W. 125 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Brantford Lane; thence along the eastern side of Brantford Lane, S. 5-19 E. 80 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner; being a portion of the property conveyed to the granting corporation by Elizabeth V. Cox, et al., by deed dated February 16, 1955, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 519, at Page 493. 317-4-14
