KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That DUKE POWER COMPANY, a corporation, in consideration of \$1.00 to it in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents by SOUTH CAROLINA HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has granted, quitclaimed and released, and by these presents does grant, quitclaim and release unto the said South Carolina Highway Department, its successors and assigns, a right of way for constructing, improving and maintaining the road above referred to being located within the City of Greer as shown by plans prepared by the State Highway Department. The property over which said right of way is granted is that lot described in deed from Grace W. Shilletter to Duke Power Company dated October 27, 1947, recorded in the Public Registry of Greenville County in Book 339 at page 449.

Said right of way is the portion of said lot lying within 30 feet of the center line of Brushy Creek Road and being the portion of said lot lying east of red line shown on print File No. 4-53 dated December 9, 1947, last revised April 4, 1949, a copy of which is hereto attached.

This instrument is and shall be binding upon the parties hereto, their successors and assigns.
