name, nature, kind and description, whether of wool, cotton, linen, silk or other material or substance;

To manufacture, buy, sell, import, export and generally deal in all goods, wares, merchandise and property of every class and description, except bills of exchange and gold and silver bullion;

To manufacture, sell and deal in machinery, tools and factory supplies and equipment necessary or suitable for use in the manufacture of yarns, cloths, fabrics, garments and textiles;

To enter into, make, form and carry out contracts of overy kind with any person, firm, association, corporation, private, public or municipal, or body politic, with the Covernment of the United States, or any State or territory thereof, or any foreign Government, so far as, and to the outent that the same may be done and permitted by corporations corporations organized under the Business Corporations Law;

To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, lands, and buildings for the erection and establishment of a manufactory or manufactories and workshops, with suitable plant, ongines and machinery, with a view to the manufacture, purchase or otherwise dealing in any objects, articles, substances or materials which the directors may deem proper, convenient or advantageous;

To acquire the property and good will of any other going business of a character in which this corporation may laufully entage, and the benefit of all pending contracts and the stock in trade thereof, together with the patents and other rights and privileges relating to said business vested in, or held on behalf of the owners thereof; to
