IN THE PRESENCE OF:

- 7. No live stock, cattle, swine, sheep, goats, or other such animals of similar breed shall be permitted to be kept on any residential plot.
- 8. No obnoxious or offensive trade or activity shall be carried on upon any of the property nor shall anything be done thereon which may be or become an annoyance or nuisance to the neighborhood.
- 9. All sewerage disposal shall be by septic tank meeting the approval of the State Board of Health or by municipal sewerage system.
- 10. An easement of five (5) feet in width is reserved along the side and rear of all lots for the purpose of utility installation and maintenance as well as drainage.
- 11. On Lots 21, 23, and 24 houses shall face Pleasantdale Circle in the following manner: The house on Lot 21 shall face Pleasantdale Circle in an easterly direction looking toward Lot No. 1 of Pleasantdale Circle; the house on Lot 23 shall face Lots 12 and 13, and the house on Lot 24 shall face Lots 8 and 9. In other words, if Pleasantdale Circle were other than one continuous street these houses would face the intersections.
- 12. The property on plat of Pleasantdale which fronts on Laurens Road (U. S. Highway 276) and extends in a westerly direction back to Lots 1 and 20 is specifically excluded from these restrictions.
