

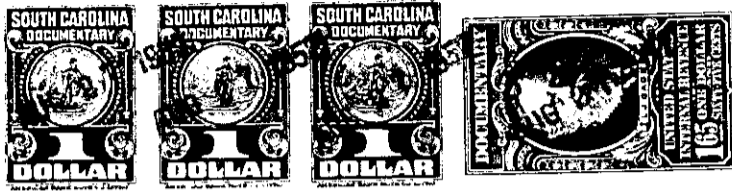

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That WE, JEAN M. CRAWFORD, J. C.  
CRAWFORD, EVELYN TAYLOR, and R. A. CRAWFORD, JR.

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Two Hundred and  
No/100----- Dollars

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by The City of Greenville, S. C.,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, S. C.,  
its successors and assigns, forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land with all improvements thereon,  
situate, lying and being in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lots  
5 and 6, Section "C", Blue Ridge Forest, property of Carolina Mountains,  
Inc., according to a plat prepared by E. S. Draper, Engineer,  
dated April, 1926, and having the following description:

LOT 5 begins at an iron pin on the Western edge of Saluda Drive at  
the Southeast corner of Lot 4; runs thence in a Southerly direction  
along the Western edge of said Saluda Drive, 85 feet to an iron pin  
at the Northeast corner of Lot 6; thence with Lot 6, due West, 161.6  
feet to an iron pin; thence N. 0-36 E., 83.8 feet to an iron pin in  
the Southern side of Lot 4; thence with line of said Lot 4, due  
East, 170 feet to an iron pin at the point of beginning, and being  
the same property conveyed to R. A. Crawford by deed of Carolina  
Mountains, Inc., dated October 24, 1928, recorded in the RMC Office  
for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 571, page 9.

LOT 6 begins at an iron pin on the Western edge of Saluda Drive at  
the Southeast corner of Lot 5; runs thence in a Southern direction  
along the Western edge of said Saluda Drive, 90 feet to an iron pin;  
thence due West, 165 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 0-36 E., 90  
feet to an iron pin at the Southwest corner of Lot 5; thence with  
Lot 5, due East, 161.6 feet to an iron pin at the beginning corner,  
and being the same property conveyed to R. A. Crawford by deed of  
Carolina Mountains, Inc., dated August 31, 1926, recorded in the  
RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 131, page 18.

SUBSEQUENTLY R. A. Crawford died testate and the grantors herein  
are his devisees under his will, an exemplified copy of which is on  
record in the Office of the Judge of Probate in Greenville County,  
S. C., in Apartment 658, File 11.

ALSO all interest which the Grantors have in and to any lands lying  
within the boundaries of any road or street, adjacent to, bounding  
or running through the above described property.
