A certain Tract or parcel of land lying and being in Glassy Mountain Town *Ship Creek* county S.C. on waters of *Jamison's mill creek*, on South side waters of *South Canal*, Beginning on a white oak 3⁺ running Thence *N 13 1/2 E. 31-1/4 chains to a black oak gone, stone*, instead 3⁺, running Thence *S 68 E. 13-28 ch. to a locust corner gone, new stone instead 3⁺*, Thence *S 6 E 13-25 chains to a chestnut 3⁺*, Thence *S 42 3/4 E. 13-18 chains to a chestnut-oak 3⁺*, Thence *S 11 1/2 E. about 7 chains to Jamison's mill creek*, Thence down the meanderings of said creek to a stone on bank of creek; Thence *N 30 1/2 E. about 41-5 chains to a cross stake now a stone 3⁺*; Thence *N 25 1/2 W 2.75 chains to the Beginning white oak corner 3⁺*; supposed to contain one hundred acres be the same, more or less, *Adjoining lands D.M.
