All those two tracts of land on which is located Pelham Colored School about nine miles below Greenville on Pelham Road in Butler Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, and being described as follows:

- 1. BEGINNING at a stake on the property line of Betty Malker and running thence 5. 3°45' = 472'0" to a stake; thence S \$5°30' W 117'0" to a corner stone; thence with Betty Walker's line S 8°0' W 217'0" to an iron pin; thence with Betty Walker's line S 25°30' E 271'6" to beginning corner, containing one acre, more or less.
- 2. BEGINNING at a stake at the corner of Lizzie Griffith's property on the Greenville Pelham Road, running thence N. 25° 30' W 442'0" to an iron pin; thence with Lizzie Griffith's line, N. 8°0" E 217'0" to a corner stone; thence N 8°0' W 46'0" to a stake; thence 3°0' W 491'6" to a stake on Greenville Pelham road; thence with said road, S 60°30' E 264'6" to beginning corner, containing one acre, more or less.
