KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Board of Trustees of School District of Greenville County No. 520,
and corporate under the laws of the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and No/100 (\$200.00) Dollars,
to in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto
Mt. Bethel Baptist Church, its successors and assigns:

All those two tracts of land located in the former Eastview School District No. 4 G, now numbered Tax District 105, in Greenville County, S. C., being described as follows:

- 1. A tract of forty one-hundredths (.40) acres conveyed by the officers and members of Working Benevolence Society, Oaklawn Lodge 78 to H. P. Beam and G. M. Rice, as Trustees of said School District, on September 30, 1926, recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Vol. 117, at page 218, reference to which is hereby made.
- 2. All that certain tract containing sixty-one hundredths (.61), acres, more or less, bounded by tract #1 above described, and property now or formerly belonging to Ollis Williams and having been conveyed by Ollis Williams to H. P. Beam and G. M. Rice, Trustees for School District 4 G, on October 4, 1926, by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Vol. 118, at page 530, reference to which is hereby made.

The grantor acquired title through statutory and judicial consolidation of all School Districts in Greenville County into one District, the grantor herein.

It is the intention of the grantor to convey to the grantee all property in which the School District has any interest and which has been used for school purposes in this location.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said.

Mt. Bethel Baptist Church, its successors

Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee, its successors and assigns against the grantor and its successors.
