in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto said Frank McElreath and Lola C. McElreath

for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them, his or her heirs and assigns, forever, in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described property, to-wit:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being known as lot number forty (40) in Hunters Acres, near Simpsonville, South Carolina and according to a plat entitled Map of Hunters Acres by C. O. Riddle, Surveyor, May, 1952, having the following courses and distances: BEGINNING at a point on the Northwest side of Florence Drive at the joint front corners of lots number 40 and 41; thence running South 1-07 West 80 feet to an iron pin; thence North 88-53 West 312 feet to an iron pin which is located 10 feet from branch line; thence along the meanders of said branch as a line by a traverse line North 52-2 East 90/1 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along said branch as a line by a traverse line 23.2 feet to an iron pin which is situated 20 feet from said branch; thence South 80-00 East 237.8 feet to the beginning point.
