All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, situate about two miles West of the City of Greenville, and being the subdivision known as Summit View, consisting of Lots Nos. 14, 15, 16 and 17 in Block "E", as shown by plat of a subdivision of said Summit View recorded in Plat Book "A", page 75, R. M. C. Office for said County and State. All of these lots are on the North side of Creole Street. This being the identical lots conveyed to Johnnie Hitt by Florense Davis, et al, by deed dated January 25, 1934, recorded in Book 171 of Deeds, at page 451, of the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.

Also, Lot No. 18 as shown by plat of the subdivision known as Summit View on plat recorded in Plat Book "A" at page 75, in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.
