to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said JACK L. LOWERY, his heirs and assigns

All that lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 20 on plat of PINEBROOK EXTENSION, recorded in Plat Book W, page 73 and a rear portion of Lot No. 11, Block E, on plat of MAYFAIR ESTATES, recorded in Plat Book S, pages 72 and 73 of the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., and according to said plat having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Runyon Drive, the front joint corner of Lots Nos. 20 and 21 of PINEBROOK EXTENSION, and running thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 12-34 W. 130.8 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 9 of MAYFAIR ESTATES; thence with the rear line of Lots Nos. 9 and 10 of Mayfair Estates, S. 68-04 W. 67.1 feet to an iron pin; thence with the joint line of Lots Nos. 10 and 11, N. 21-56 W. 25 feet to an iron pin; thence across Lot No. 11, S. 68-04 W. 27.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 11-38 E. 140 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Runyon Drive; the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 19 and 20 of Pinebrook Extension; thence with the northern side of Runyon Drive, N. 77-27 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

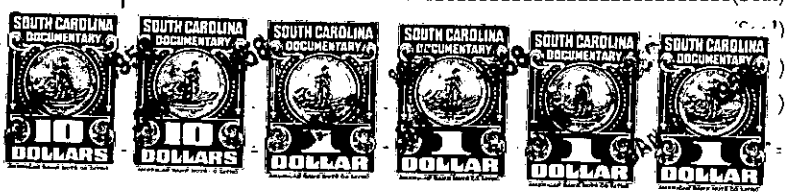
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.
