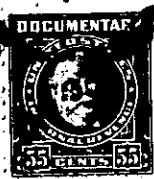

Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Eugene G. Holliday

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in West Dunklin Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, containing forty (40) acres, more or less,
and being the remaining portion of the E. H. and P. G. Acker lands, which said
said forty (40) acres is bounded on the North by a portion of said Acker
place, now owned and occupied by Mrs. Ruth Holliday, on the East by lands
now belonging to the E. H. Acker Estate, on the South by Saluda River
and on the West by the Hendrix Vaughan place, now owned by W. R. Haynie.
It being the intention to convey in this tract the remaining portion of
said Acker tract exclusive of the portions belonging to Ruth C. Holliday
