All and singular, all that certain lot of land, situate, lying and being about one (1) mile outside the Incorporate Limits of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina. The said lot lies at the intersection of Gordon Street and Owens Street and being described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of Gordon Street and Owens Street and thence with the south side of Gordon Street S 79-45 W. 70 feet to the corner of lot 25 on Gordon Street; thence with Lot 25 S 10-15 E 200 feet to pin rear corner of Lot 25; thence N 79-45 E 70 feet to the west side of Owens Street; thence with Owens Street N. 10-15 W 200 feet to the beginning corner, according to the plat made by W.
