to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said SALLIE GARRETT WATSON AND HER HEIRS:

All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situated and lying in the County and State aforesaid containing forty-six and three-fourths acres, more or less, being the same conveyed to me by J. L. Campbell by deed dated Dec. 4th. 1911 and recorded in the Office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 17 at page 24, the said lands having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stone 3X on Neely Ferry Road, and running thence S. 15 1/2 W. 18.75 to stone 3X; thence S. 45 E. 8.50 to a stone 3X; thence N. 57 1/2 E. 18.00 to a stone 3X; thence N. 33 1/2 E. 7.50 to a stone 3X; thence N. 20 e/4 W. 15.20 to a stone 3X; thence S. 68 3/4 W. 16.24 to a stone 3X to the beginning corner being the same tract of land formerly conveyed to J. L. Campbell by me and since then having been reconveyed to me by same Campbell. Deed Recorded in Deed Book 28, page 63.

Further, Land purchased from W. M. Weaver by J. W. Watson, recorded in Deed Book 66, page 243; beginning at a stone in public road running from Simpsonville by J. B. Wasson's Store, thence S. 64-30 E. S. 3 6 7 to stone 3X; thence N. 6 W. 10.60 to stone 3X; thence N. 69.45 W. 29.65 to stone in road; thence S. 14 W. 6.57 to the beginning corner, containing 24.93 acres more or less, Bounded on the North by lands of O. F. Henderson, on the East by lands of Stewart Fowler, on the South by Wood Place, and on the West by the Public Road and being a part of the tract of land conveyed to me by deed of Maggie H. Peden on Jan. 1, 1919 said deed being recorded in R. M. C. Office in Deed Book 51, page 258.
