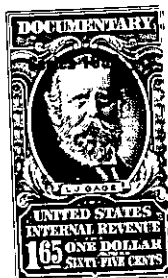

Gilstrap, his Heirs and Assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 18 on Plat of Cherokee Forest, Map #2, recorded in Plat Book EE, at pages 190 and 191, and having, according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeastern side of Windemere Drive, at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 17 and 18, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 17, N. 56-30 E. 175 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 33-30 W. 100 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 18 and 19; thence with the line of Lot No. 19, S. 56-30 W. 175 feet to an iron pin on Windemere Drive; thence with said Windemere Drive, S. 33-30 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.
