to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Leland J. Alewine

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Leland J. Alewine

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Spring Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, consisting of Lots Nos 37 and 39 as shown on plat prepared by the Piedmont Engineering Service, Greenville S.C., in August, 1947, and recorded in R.M.C. office, Greenville County, in Plat Book 3, page 19, with metes and bounds as follows:

Lot. No. 37. Beginning at an iron pin on Taylors Road, formerly known as Brushy Creek Road, at corner between Lots Nos. 37 and 39, thence N 75° 25' E 206.5 feet to common corner of Lots Nos. 38, 39 and 40; thence along line of Lot. No. 38 N 14° 35' W 71.6 feet to common corner of Lots Nos. 36 and 38; thence S 75° 25' W 206.5 feet to corner on Taylors Road; thence along Taylors Road S 14° 35' E 71.6 feet to point of beginning.

Lot No. 39. Beginning at iron pin on Taylors Road, formerly known as Brushy Creek Road, at corner between Lots. Nos. 39 and 41, thence N 75° 25' E 206.5 feet to common corner with Lots Nos. 40, 41 and 42; thence N 14° 35' W 70 feet to common corner of Lots Nos 37, 38 and 40; thence along line of Lot No. 37, S 75° 25' W 206.5 feet to an iron pin on Taylors Road; thence along Taylors Road S 14° 35' E 70 feet to point of beginning.
