a. Execute vouchers in my name and all allowances or reimbursements properly payable to me from The United States, including allowances from transportation of dependents, and to indorse and collect the proceeds of checks payable to me, drawn on The Treasurer of The United States.

b. To prepare, execute and file income tax or other tax returns, or all other applications or returns of any nature required by governmental agencies.

And generally to:

a. Perform all and every act, deed, matter, and thing whatsoever in and about my estate, property, and affairs, as fully as I might or could do in my own proper person, the above specifically enumerated powers being in aid of the full, complete, and general power herein granted and not in limitation thereof; and I hereby ratify all my said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of this power.
