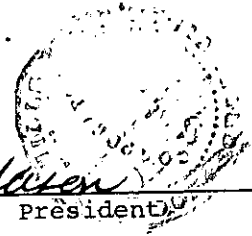
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the property, easements, rights and privileges above mentioned unto Duke Power Company, its successors and assigns, forever.
