It is the intention of the grantors and the grantees herein to establish a permanent boundary between their adjacent tracts of land as surveyed and platted as shown above. By virtue of deed from Sybil C. Burns dated July 2, 1951 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Deed Vol. 453 at page 268, Rolls Mayfield became the owner of anundivided one-third interest and George R. Mayfield, III became the owner of the remaining two-thirds interest in and to 82 3/4 acres, more or less, in Bates Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, the east boundary of which overlapped the west boundary of the grantees herein.
