the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

forever: JOE MELVIN PARKS and ST. LAWRENCE PARKS, their heirs and assigns,

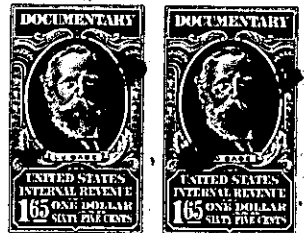
ALL that lot of land with improvements lying on the Eastern side of Blossom Drive in Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 30 on a Plat of KENNEDY PARK, made by Piedmont Engineers and Architects, dated September 28, 1964, as revised, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book JJJ, page 179, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Blossom Drive at joint front corners of Lots Nos. 30 and 31, and running thence S. 87-05 E., 140 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 1-36 E., 21.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 3-01 E., 55.9 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corners of Lots Nos. 29 and 30; thence along the common line of said lots, N. 83-01 W., 118.6 feet to an iron pin on Blossom Drive; thence with the curve of the Eastern side of Blossom Drive, the chord of which is S. 25-41 W., 55.4 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the Eastern side of Blossom Drive, S. 2-55 W., 34.6 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

The above described property is hereby conveyed subject to rights of way, easements and setback lines shown on the aforementioned recorded plat and appearing of public record and to restrictive covenants applicable to Kennedy Park, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 773, page 527.

As a part of the consideration for this deed, the Grantees assume and agree to pay in full the indebtedness due on a note and mortgage to Carolina Federal Savings and Loan Association, recorded in the RMC Office for said County and State in Mortgage Book 1040, page 22, which has a present balance due of \$7,700.00 plus accrued interest.

Grantees agree to pay 1966 Greenville County taxes.
