

5. To continue, carry on and transact all and every kind of business now conducted by me or in which I may have any right, title or interest, and to establish and engage in any business which, in the opinion of my attorney, may be for my advantage or benefit;

7. And I do hereby, for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, agree to and do hereby, expressly ratify and confirm whatsoever my said attorney shall do or cause to be done in or about the premises by virtue of these presents.
