presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said A. C. Lister, Bobby Joe Lister, and

George Foister, as Trustees of Eden Pilgrim Holiness Church, and to their successors in office in trust for the use and benefit of the ministry and membership of the Pilgrim Holiness Church in the United States of America, subject to the Manual of said church as from time to time revised and authorized,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lot No. 22 and one-half (½) of Lot No. 20, adjoining Lot No. 22 in Block "F" of the subdivision of Park Place, as shown on plat thereof recorded in plat book "A" at page 119 of the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, said lot having a frontage of 75 feet on Second (2nd) Avenue, and having a depth of 150 feet, on Second (2nd) Street.
