8. The general nature of the business for which the corporation is organized is (it is not necessary to set forth in the purposes powers enumerated in Section 2.2) (12—12.2 Supplemental Code 1962)

To own and operate manufacturing or production plants or processing facilities dealing in and with the application by heat or other methods of any and all coating or covering materials to every type of metal product, device and appliance; to perform, transact and carry on the business usually done by companies of this type; and to do any and all acts necessary and conducive to the aforesaid purposes.

9. Provisions which the incorporators elect to include in the articles of incorporation are as follows:
