A portion of that certain tract or parcel of land located on Headwaters of South Tyger River, containing 55 3/4 acres conveyed from Laurie A. Southerlin to W. B. Southerlin by deed or other means of conveyance dated February 9, 1952 and recorded in Book of Deeds, Volume 451, Page 63, Office R.M.C. in Greenville County, South Carolina which description, by reference, is incorporated herein.

A portion of that certain tract or parcel of land located on Headwaters of South Tyger River, containing 11 3/4 acres, conveyed from M. G. Southerlin to W. B. Southerlin by deed or other means od conveyance dated December 4, 1943 and recorded in Book of Deeds, Volume 269, Page 435, Office of R. M. C. in Greenville County, South Carolina which description, by reference, is incorporated herein.

A portion of that certain tract or parcel of land located on Headwaters of South Tyger River, containing 6.15 acres conveyed from Carl Stewart, Armond Stewart and Irene Stewart Johnson to W. B. Southerlin by deed or other means of conveyance dated December 20,1960 and recorded in Book of Deeds, Volume 665, Page 328, Office of E.M.C. in Greenville County, South Carolina which description, by reference, is incorporated herein.

For the permanent storage and temporary detention, either or both, of any waters that are impounded, stored, or detained, and for the maintenance and inspection of areas to be flooded by floodwater retarding structure, designated as Site No. One in the plans for South Tyger River Watershed.

The approximate location of the area involved in the easement herein conveyed is shown on Sketch Map of Floodwater Retarding Structure No. One, South Tyger Watershed in Greenville County, South Carolina, recorded in Plat Book, Volume 000, Page 27, Office of the R.M.C. Greenville County, South Carolina, which sketch map is, by reference, incorporated in and made a part of this instrument.

- 1. In the event construction of the works of improvement herein described is not commenced within 72 months from the date hereof, the rights and privileges herein granted shall at once revert to the Grantor, his(her) heirs and assigns.
- 2. This easement includes the right of ingress and egress at any time over and upon the above described land and any adjoining land owned by the Grantor necessary to accomplish the works of improvement specified above.
- 3. There is reserved to the Grantor, his (her) heirs and assigns, the right and privilege to use the above described land of the Grantor at any time, in any manner and for any purpose not inconsistent with the full use and enjoyment by the Grantee, its successors and assigns, of the rights and privileges herein granted.
