

the said Robert Bruce White himself, shall be a full acquittal and discharge of the Trustee to the extent of the payment so made.- In making any such payments, or in holding principal or income for the said Robert Bruce White, the Trustee shall have all of the powers and discretions conferred upon him in Paragraph IV hereof.

(c) When the said Robert Bruce White shall have attained the age of twenty-one (21) years, this trust shall thereupon terminate and the Trustee shall pay over to the said Robert Bruce White absolutely, the entire undistributed principal and income of this trust. If the said Robert Bruce White should die before the final distribution of principal and income as aforesaid, this trust shall thereupon terminate and the Trustee shall pay over all the undistributed principal and income thereof then held by him, to such person or persons or entities (including the estate of the said Robert Bruce White) as he may have appointed during his life; or in default of such appointment, or to the extent said power of appointment is not exercised, said principal and income shall be paid to the heirs of the said Robert Bruce White.

(d) As hereinabove provided in this Paragraph, it is the express intent of the Donors that all of the property comprising this trust and the income therefrom may be expended by, or for the benefit of the said Robert Bruce White, until he shall attain the age of twenty-one (21) years, and to the extent not so expended shall be paid over to him absolutely in accordance with the foregoing provisions of sub-paragraph (c).

In addition to the powers and discretions hereinabove conferred and those conferred upon fiduciaries by law, and
