

B. The other undivided interest shall vest as follows:

1. If Helen F. Willimon is then living, an undivided one-half interest shall vest in her.

2. If Helen F. Willimon is then deceased, her undivided half interest shall go to Heyward Willimon.

3. If Helen F. Willimon and Heyward Willimon are both then deceased, and if Edith F. Reid is then living, the said half interest shall go to Edith F. Reid, free of any trust, or if Edith F. Reid be then deceased said share shall go to her daughter, Anna Victoria Reid, under the provisions of (2) above.


The property subject to this trust is described as follows:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing three acres, more or less, according to plat of same by Terry T. Dill, C.E. & L.S., January 1948 and having the following metes and bounds:

Pittman and running thence along Thompson Road, S. 47-09 W., 353.8 feet to iron pin near street intersection ; thence N. 67-50 W. 192.6 feet to iron pin; thence N. 14-35 W., 97.3 feet to nail and cap; thence N. 1-52 W., 125.1 feet to iron pin; N. 23-25 E., 131.8 feet to iron pin; thence N. 7-20 E. 65 feet to iron pin in road; thence S. 68-10 E., 21 feet to iron pin on Ramsey line; thence S. 57-10 E., 462 feet to beginning corner.
