HUMBLE OIL & REFINING COMPANY:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, located on the western side of Texas Avenue, and having the following metes and bounds as shown on a plat of Humble Oil & Refining Company prepared by Webb Surveying and Mapping Company on November 30, 1967, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Texas Avenue, which point is located 110 feet north of the intersection of Easley Bridge Road and Texas Avenue, and running thence with the western side of Texas Avenue, N 22-00 W., 37.7 feet to a point; turning and running thence S 71-00 W., 70 feet to a point; turning and running thence S 22-00 E., 37.7 feet to a point; turning and running thence N 71-00 E., 70 feet to a point on the edge of Texas Avenue, the point of beginning.
