the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto

Ed Johnson, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All my right, title and interest, being a 1/36th interest, in and to:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located on the eastern side of the C & W C Railway in the Town of Mauldin, adjoining property formerly owned by Green and Austin, et al, containing 2 acres, more or less, and having according to plat prepared by W. J. Riddle, July 1948, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the right-of-way of the C & W C Railway and joint corner with property now or formerly of Green, and running thence along line of said property, N 83-08 E 625.5 feet to an iron pin on line of property now or formerly of Austin; thence with said property, S 0-25 E 75 feet to an iron pin; thence still with line of said property, S 4-11 E 287.2 feet to an iron pin in line of property formerly of Shaver; thence along line of said property, S 80-13 W 23 feet to an iron pin; thence N 41-21 W 365.8 feet to a stake; thence S 76-44 W 350.7 feet to a stake on the right-of-way of the C & W C Railway; thence with said right-of-way, N 17-38 W 105.7 feet to the beginning corner.

Being the same property conveyed to Ed Johnson and Alice Johnson by deed recorded in Deed Book 356 at page 489 in the RMC Office for Greenville County, Alice Johnson having died intestate on September 8, 1967, thereby vesting a 1/36th interest in the grantor.

This property is shown as Tract 1 on plat of Property of J. E. Johnson recorded in Plat Book YYY at page 51, RMC for said County, said plat being dated July 1948.
