WHEREAS, by indenture dated April 20, 1946, recorded in Deed Book 294, page 142, of the public records of Greenville County, South Carolina, C. T. Smith and Carrie L. Smith conveyed to Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, a New York corporation, its successors and assigns, a Clearance Permit for telephone lines on and over that certain piece of land at Mauldin, Greenville County, South Carolina, described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the center line of Old Mill Road and the southeasterly boundary line of the right of way of Seaboard Coast Line Railroad Company's Laurens-Greenville main track, said boundary line being parallel with and 100 feet southeastwardly, measured at right · angles or radially, from the center line of said main track; running thence northeastwardly, along said southeasterly right of way boundary line on a curve to the right having the following chords and distances: North 10° 19' East, 184.6 feet; North 12° 23' East, 200 feet; North 14° 18' East, 200 feet; North 16° 47' East, 294.5 feet; North 19° 35' East, 249 feet; North 21° 20' East, 544 feet; thence South 57° 16' East, 2713.8 feet; thence South 13° West, 99.2 feet; thence South 19° West, 300.4 feet to the center line of Devonshire Road; thence continue South 19° West, along the center line of Devonshire Road, 600 feet; thence continue along the last mentioned center line South 33° 02' West, 103.1 feet; thence continue along said last mentioned center line South 19º West, 433.1 feet to the center line of said Old Mill Road; thence along the center line of said Old Mill Road North 60° 44' West, 1169 feet; thence continue along the center line of said Old Mill Road North 590 07' West, 1449.9 feet to the point of beginning.

NOW THEREFORE, the said Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company has relinquished and disclaimed and by these presents does relinquish and disclaim any claim, title, right of possession or possession in and to the above described land.
