WHEREAS, the School District of Greenville County is the owner of a tract of land on the east side of Garrison Road, which is the site of the Simpsonville Junior High School, located in the Mauldin-Simpsonville-Fountain Inn Water District, and

WHEREAS, the School District of Greenville County has installed a six inch cast iron water line tying onto the existing sixteen inch line of the Mauldin-Simpsonville-Fountain Inn Water District on Highway 14 at its intersection with Alice Avenue, and thence a six inch cast iron line along Alice Avenue to Sunrise Avenue; thence a six inch cast iron line along Sunrise Avenue to Garrison Road; thence a six inch cast iron line in a southerly direction along Garrison Road to Arlene Avenue and an eight inch cast iron line along Garrison Road in a northerly direction to the site of the aforementioned Junior High School, making a total of 3,267 linear feet of six inch cast iron pipe and 1,483 linear feet of eight inch cast iron pipe along with necessary tapping valves, sleeves, boxes, relief valves, bends, plugs, etc., which line was installed by Tankersley Dirt Moving Company, has been tested, and is satisfactory to Mauldin-Simpson-ville-Fountain Inn Water District,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises contained herein on the part of Mauldin-Simpsonville-Fountain Inn Water District, the School District of Greenville County does, by its duly authorized officers, sell, transfer, set over and convey to Mauldin-Simpsonville-Fountain Inn Water District, its successors and assigns, the aforementioned water lines along with all valves, fittings and accounterments thereto.
