sold, released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Administrator of Veterans' Affairs, an Officer of the United States of America, and his successors in such office, as such, and his or their assigns, forever:

> "All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the easterly side of Assembly Drive (formerly Belmont Avenue), near the City of Greenville, S. C., and being designated as Lot No. 43 on the subdivision of the Perry Property as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book O, Page 45, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the easterly side of Assembly Drive, joint corner of Lots 43 and 44, and running thence N 87-45 E 135 feet to an iron pin; thence N 5-50 W 55 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 42 and 43; thence along the common line of said lots S 87-45 W 135 feet to an iron pin on the easterly side of Assembly Drive; thence along said Drive S 5-50 E 55 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning."
