Louie H. Gregory and Daphne L. Gregory, their heirs and assigns forever:

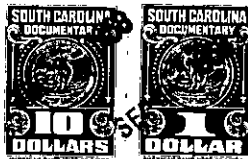
All those pieces, parcels or lots of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina on South Carolina Highway 93 (Noe Road) and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 5 and 6 on a plat entitled "Property of W. H. Alford" which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "BBB", at Page 183 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of South Carolina Highway 93, joint front corner of Tract No. 6 and property formerly of Thompson and running thence S. 31-0 E. 1167 feet to a stone; thence with the rear line of Lots Nos. 5 and 6 S. 72-01 W. 460 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5; thence with the common line of said lots N. 34-47 W. 973.1 feet to a point in the center of South Carolina Highway 93; thence with said Highway the following courses and distances, to-wit: N. 61-10 E. 220 feet to a point; thence continuing N. 56-04 E. 100 feet to a point; thence continuing N. 42-50 E. 100 feet; thence continuing N. 29-30 E. 110.4 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
