Alexander, his heirs and assigns, an easement and right-ofway for roadway purposes over and across that certain strip of land being twenty-five feet (25) in width paralleling the southeast boundary of Lot 13 for the purpose of allowing the said Grantee, his heirs and assigns, ingress and egress in and to that certain tract of land abutting the southwest boundary of the Grantor's lot, it being understood that the grading, surfacing, maintenance and operation of the said easement shall be entirely at no cost or expense to the Grantor and the Grantee shall indemnify and hold the Grantor harmless from any liability by reason of the death or injury of persons or damage to property resulting in any action from the exercise of this easement; that by the acceptance of this easement, the Grantor is relieved of any responsibility to warn the Grantee, his heirs and assigns and her agents and invitees of any danger connected with the use of the said right-of-way.
