This being the same tract of land owned by J. H. Alewine at his death; having been conveyed to the said J. H. Alewine by J. F. Freeman and D. R. Freeman by deed dated 25th March, 1909 and being recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 18 at page 357. There being excluded from this conveyance 2.5 acres of the original tract heretofore conveyed to William J. Batson by deed dated 30th September 1947, said deed being recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 372 at page 2.

The said trustee is to hold and manage the property herein conveyed and shall have the power to borrow money in his name as trustee upon such terms and conditions as he may deem advisable, and to mortgage all or any part of the property herein conveyed, as security for the

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
