in consideration of \$1.00 and correction of description Dollars,  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto MAUDE BROWN, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the Town of Simpsonville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Easterly side of East South Main Street, being shown as Lots No. 9, 10 and 11 on Plat entitled, "Property of Alvis Brooks, et al", prepared by C. O. Riddle, dated October, 1968, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Easterly side of East South Main Street, located at joint front corner of property belonging to Mary Elizabeth Mabry and running thence with the Easterly side of East South Main Street, N. 3-02 W., 160 feet to an iron pin in line of property of Mark and Maude B. Brown; thence N. 86-58 E., 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 3-02 W., 100 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 86-58 E., 103.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 10-25 E., 126.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 74-51 W., 110 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 13-54 E., 108.1 feet to an old iron pin; thence with the line of property of Mabry, S. 85-14 W., 182.3 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
