

If the two arbitrators cannot agree on the appointment of said third arbitrator, either may petition the Court of Common Pleas, Greenville County for appointment of the third arbitrator. In the event any two arbitrators determine that said Committee did disapprove said proposed improvements without reasonable justification, then, and upon making such determination, said arbitrators shall succeed to the role of said Committee (only as to this particular property owner) and shall have the full power and authority to approve or disapprove a proposed improvement. The decisions of any two arbitrators shall be final and conclusive. The expense of arbitration shall be borne equally between the parties.

2. By changing the original Architectural and Design Committee by eliminating Douglas C. Crouch and substituting Fannie I. Cromwell.
