PURCHASE AND SALE AGREEMENT

## WITNESSETH:

That the Seller agrees to sell and Purchasers agree to buy the property hereinafter described for the sum of Five Thousand and No/100 (\$5,000.00) Dollars, to be paid as follows: \$1,000.00 down at the execution of this agreement, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the Seller, and the balance of \$4,000.00 to be paid at the closing.

The Seller agrees to convey the property by good warranty deed, free of liens, encumbrances and assessments, on payment of the purchase price as above provided. Transaction to be closed, taxes, interest and rents, if any, to be pro-rated on or before September 4, 1969. Possession of the property to be given upon the closing of the transaction. Time is of the essence of this contract and this contract embodies the entire agreement between the parties.

## Description of Property:
