RIGHT OF WAY

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of Three Hundred and No/100ths (\$300.00) Dollars to the undersigned in hand paid by Duke Power Company, the receipt whereof being hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant unto the said Duke Power Company, a right of way or easement along, over and under the property of the Grantors more particularly described below for the purpose of installing and maintaining an underground drainage line, including necessary manholes, together with the right of ingress and egress for the purpose of inspecting and maintaining the same. The aforesaid right of way shall have a total width of thirty (30) feet during construction and thereafter said right of way shall extend two and one-half (2½) feet on each side of said drainage line as installed.

The premises affected by the right of way granted herein are described as follows:

All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being on the Northeastern side of Northside Circle, near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being a portion of the premises conveyed to E. Greer by deed of F. B. Massingale, dated June 5, 1946, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 296 at page 128.

All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being on the Southwestern side of Northside Circle near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being a portion of the premises conveyed to E. Greer by deed of W. H. Greer, dated April 3, 1919, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 56 at page 3.

The right of way granted herein is more particularly described as follows:
