to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said JACK L. SUTTLES & RAY H. SUTTLES, their heirs and assigns, forever:

All my one-fifty-sixth (1/56) right, title and interest as one of the four heirs of W. Stuart Barr, Sr., who had a one-fourteenth (1/14) interest in and to the hereinafter described property:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being Lot No. 1, on a plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville, South Carolina, in Plat Book "C", at page 176, and according to said plat having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at the corner of Ladson Street and Mills Avenue and running thence with Mills Avenue s. 45-27 w. 65 feet; thence s. 44-33 e. with line of Lot no. 2 180 feet to an iron pin on an alley; thence with said alley n. 45-27 e. 65 feet to an iron pin on Ladson Street; thence along Ladson Street n. 44-33 w. 180 feet to the beginning corner.
