All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lot No. 2 as shown on a plat prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, dated August 1969, entitled "Property of J. P. Stevens & Co., Inc. - Monaghan Plant", recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book 4G at page 17 (Said lot lies adjacent to the rear line of Lot No. 27 which fronts on the Eastern side of Crest Street, which lot is shown on a plat prepared by Dalton & Neves, dated December 1941, entitled "Map of Victor-Monaghan Co. - Development No. 1", and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book M at page 39), and having according to the first mentioned plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 27 and 28 of Victor-Monaghan Co. Development No. 1, and at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2 and running thence with the line of Lot No. 1 S. 75-39 E. 66.97 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 2, 1, 13 and 12; thence with the lines of Lots Nos. 12 and 11 S. 17-32 W. 70 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 11 and at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 2 and 3; thence with the line of Lot No. 3 N. 67-16 W. 70 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 26 and 27; thence with the line of Lot No. 27 N. 20-16 E. 60 feet to the point of beginning.
