MEMORANDUM OF CONTRACT

THIS MEMORANDUM OF CONTRACT made and entered into this 30th day of December, 1969, by and between W. C. Murrell (also known as William Clarkston Murrell), the Seller, and C. B. Martin, Jr. and C. S. Martin, the Purchasers.

For valuable considerations staisfactory to the parties hereto and pursuant to a real estate contract of even date herewith between the Seller and the Purchasers, the Seller has agreed to sell and the Purchasers have agreed to purchase the following described property:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being on the Eastern side of Grove Road in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing 1.12 acres, more or less, according to plat dated November 24, 1969, entitled "Survey for C. B. Martin Company" prepared by Piedmont Engineers & Architects, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
