shown on a plat entitled "Sheet One of Addition to Knollwood Heights,":dated March 23, 1968, and recorded in said RMC Office in Plat Book 4-F, at Page 17, and Lots 74 through 80, inclusively, as shown on a plat entitled "Sheet Two of Knollwood Heights," dated March 23, 1968 and recorded in said RMC Office in Plat Book 4-F, at Page 18.

The above mentioned restrictions which are imposed and adopted as the restrictions and protective covenants applicable to the above mentioned Lot 16 and Lots 74 through 90, inclusively, are hereby amended, as to Lot 16 and Lots 74 through 90, inclusively, as follows:

- Lot 16 and Lots 74 through 90, inclusively, shall not be subject to Paragraph 3 of said protective covenants but shall be subject to the following:
 - "No dwelling shall be erected on any lot with the ground floor area of the main structure, exclusive of porches, carports, breezeways, garages, and unfinished basements, of less than 1,800 square feet for a one story dwelling, nor less than 1,000 square feet for a dwelling of more than one story."
- 2. No building shall be erected, placed, or altered on any building plot in this subdivision until the building plans, specifications and plot plan showing the location of such building have been approved in writing as to conformity and harmony of external design with existing structures in the subdivision, and as to location of the building with respect to topography and finished ground elevation by a committee composed of Wilkins Norwood, James L. Sanderson and John C. Kulze, Jr., or by a representative designated by a majority of the members of said committee. In the event of the death or resignation of any member of said committee, the remaining member or members shall have full authority to approve or disapprove such design and location or to designate a representative with like authority. In the event said committee, or its designated representative fails to approve or disapprove such design and location with 30 days after said plans and specifications have been submitted to it, or in any event, if no suit to enjoin the erection of such buildings or the making of such alterations has been commenced prior to the completion thereof, such approval will not be required and this covenant will be deemed to have been fully complied with. Neither the members of such committee, nor its designated representative will be entitled to any compensation for services performed pursuant to this covenant. The powers and duties of such committee, and of its designated representative, shall cease on and after January 1, 1995. Thereafter the approval described in this covenant
