WHEREAS, the said PIEDMONT NATURAL GAS COMPANY, Inc., has by the laying of the first pipe line constituted the selection of the route and has agreed that the right of way shall be 50 feet in width.

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that PIEDMONT NATURAL GAS COMPANY, INC., a corporation, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby establish its right of way through said property as extending 25 feet on each side of the original pipe line and does hereby waive, quitclaim and relinquish any claim to any right of way outside of said total right of way of 50 feet.

Except as herein amended, the original Right-of-Way Agreement hereinabove referred to shall remain in full force and effect.
