This matter was referred by this Court on March 3, 1970, to the Honorable Frank P. McGowan, Jr., as Master in Eqity for Greenville County, South Carolina, for the purpose of holding a reference to take testimony and report back to this Court his findings of fact, conclusions of law and recommendations.

The Master filed his report on May 26, 1970, indicating that a hearing was held on March 3, 1970, and upon review of this matter, it appears that this action was commenced by the Plaintiff by service of Complaint with Summons attached upon Loraine Harrison and James Riley Harrison; that by Affidavit signed by William D. Richardson, dated February 10, 1970, it appears that neither of the Defendants have answered, demurred or otherwise pled, and are now in default.

It further appears that the parties to this action are properly before the Court and that the real estate which is the subject of this action is located within Greenville County, South Carolina; that the real estate known as 27 acres, more or less, was deeded by Bessie Gosnell on January 3, 1960, to the Defendants, which deed is of record in the Office of the RMC for Greenville County in Deed Book 656, Page 230.

It further appears that Bessie Gosnell died intestate on February 5, 1961, and since that time the property has been of record in the mame of the Defendants hereto.
